By state statute, any vote of this significance must be preceded by an announcement at least 48 hours before the actual vote. We are also requesting the input of the neighborhood associations more closely affected by the proposed development, and should hear back from them before our vote held on April 17th meeting.

Minutes of Membership Meeting

March 20, 2006

Provided by Paula Zachem The meeting started at 7:00 pm.



Our CPO, Rich Hladik, reported that there were no major problems in our area. It was brought to everyone's attention that the traffic circle at 30th Avenue and 68th Street N was damaged the past weekend. Anyone with information on what happened was encouraged to provide that information.

Lita Sargent, Tyrone Square Mall Manager, discussed the new redevelopment in the Lifestyle area, where Bonefish Grille, Leroy Selmon's, Jos. A. Bank, and J. Jill were now open. Motherhood Maternity and Diva Day Spa were due to open at any time. She stated that most of the work was done in this area, with only some lighting and landscaping issues left to finish. She also announced that another restaurant was in the works. She discussed the proposed AMC Movie Theater redevelopment in the out parcel near JCPenny. It will have 14 screens and add a tie-in to the Pinellas Trail for easy access. EDC approval is needed for this project. Old Navy will take over the current AMC Movie Theater location.

Les Porter and Fred Bostrom, from Porter Development, discussed the proposed project for the property on 66th Street between 13th Avenue and 18th Avenue North. Two of the five buildings on the property will be torn down. A combination of condo/townhome and retail will replace what is being torn down. There will be a parking deck for the residential area. The landscaping (green space) for that project will improve what currently exists and they discussed that was the only variance they would be requesting. The condos/townhomes will be called *Royale* and the retail portion will be known as *Shoppes at the Royale*. The project is to be started this July and finished by the first quarter in 2008.

Lance Lubin, Co-President of Eagle Crest Neighborhood Association, discussed the Sembler project at 66th Street and 9th Avenue N and that they seemed to be backing down from the zone change from single family to commercial and proposing townhomes at this time.

Ron Russell discussed the flooding problems in his area of the neighborhood and what further development would do to other areas of the neighborhood if those issues weren't addressed by the City or County.

The Minutes were approved as presented in the March 2006 newsletter.

The Treasurer's Report was unanimously approved. It was reported that there were a total of 221 members, with 193 returning and 26 new members.

Tom Killian reported on the following events for the Neighborhood: Easter Egg Hunt at Walter Fuller Park on April 15, 2006, starting at 10 am and that bikes were going to be donated as prizes from St. Petersburg Police Department; Green Thumb Festival on April 29 and 30 from 9 am to 4 pm, with the free plant give-away at 8 am on both days; Neighborhood Association Baseball Nite this year is on July 21, 2006, at 7 pm with the Baltimore Orioles against the Tampa Bay Devil Rays, cost is \$5.00 per person; and the joint Neighborhood Picnic will be October 28, 2006, and Bob Miller and his bluegrass band will be playing again and PARC will be helping this year.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 pm.

JTCA immediately got to work on repairing the sign, at a cost of \$100.00 and fastening it back in place, with help from Bob Miller. Great rescue guys. (picture of the repair-persons below)

At our last meeting, it was brought to the attention of the association that damage occurred to the larger circle at 30th Ave N and 68th Street N from a vehicle accident. A police report is to be filed and the city may replant a tree for JTCA. Bob Miller and Tom Killian have tried to upright the tree for now to see if it will survive the battering which it attested.




Join in the fun and excitement of celebrating Arbor Day and Earth Day at this annual city festival.





Many varieties of **Citrus trees**, the genus includes grapefruit (Citrus paradise), small lime (Citrus aurantifolia), lemon (Citrus limon), tangelo, temple, tangerine, murcott honey, blood orange, Satsuma, kumquat and calamondin. And, there are many species and crosses. For instance, tangelo is a cross between a grapefruit and tangerine. Limequat is a cross between lime and kumquat. World wide in cultivation, sweet orange is said to have originated in India and spread by the Spanish to the new world. The citrus we grow to eat is produced on an evergreen tree. It sheds a few leaves in the spring or an insect or disease problem or after a freeze. Here is a list of some citrus and when the fruit will mature:

MATURES: September – November

Parson Brown large fruit, coarse texture Hamlin Small fruit, use for juice Robinson Tangerine type, easily peeled,

Navel Mostly seedless, peel thick, large fruit Dancy Principle tangerine variety, easily peeled

Satsuma Large, loose skinned, hardiest

MATURES: December: - February Pineapple Juice or eating, Marsh Grapefruit Large, seedless

Ruby Red Grapefruit Red fleshed with blushing

Queen orange Juice or eating

Temple many seeds, good eating Duncan Grapefruit Seedy, white flesh Few seeds, good flavor Tangelo

Murcott Honey Tangerine type, easily peeled, few seeds

MATURES: March – July

Valencia orange good for juice, very few seeds King orange large fruit, excellent flavor Meyer lemon bears fruit all year Pondorosa lemon Very large fruit, seedy

Kev lime very small, greenish pulp, highly acid

INSECTS ON CITRUS

New growth, as well as older trees may be subject to aphid damage. Malathion or soapy water will do well. White flies lay eggs on the underside of the leaf. The the larvae on the leaf. Control with an oil spray. The orange dog caterpillar, which is the larvae of the giant swallowtail butterfly, is common on young trees. Use thuricide or sevin.

FOOT ROT ON CITRUS TREES

You can have root rot, foot rot, and a fruit rot on the same tree, caused by a widely distributed fungus - Phytophthora. Lesions usually begin near the bud union, expanding either upward on the trunk or downward into the root crown. Symptoms of foot rot are water-soaking of the bark in irregular patches and oozing. Over time, bark dries out, settles, cracks and weathers off, with wood beneath the bark turning brown. If tree has developed foot rot, scrape the brown, discolored bark until you reach healthy wood, paint with a copper paint. Systemic fungicides are useful.






