



BRUCE WATTERS JEWELERS CLOSED

Bruce Watters Jewelry closed after 112 years. It was the oldest operating business in all of Pinellas County. The business was started in 1905 by Jim Watters' grandfather. His father, Bruce, moved the store to Beach Drive in 1974. When Bruce retired in 1998, Jim kept the store open in honor of his dad, who worked part-time until dying at 85, September 2016. "My wife and I are ready to enjoy some retirement," says Jim Watters. "We do not have any kids interested in running the business, so we decided to sell it." Beach Drive rents are much higher than the days his father bought much of that city block in 1975. Jim says there have been many inquiries about the space from all types of businesses.

Solar Canopy for Parking at St. Pete Pier

City Council voted to enter a lease with Duke Energy Florida to build covered parking using solar panels at the new Pier District. The project provides 100 covered parking spaces with a roof made of solar panels, said sustainability manager Sharon Wright.

"It's a pretty simple canopy structure," Wright told council. "The solar panels aren't on top of the structure . . . They are the roof structure itself." The panels are big enough to collect sufficient energy to power 40 homes a year, Wright said.

Duke Energy will own, lease and maintain the property. The project at the parking lot on the south side of the pier approach will cost \$2 million, which Duke will pay.

The walks with officers will take place every Friday in a different neighborhood. The goal is to work together against violence and promote a good relationship between police and residents.








Cost of living - how does Tampa Bay compare?

Tampa Hillsborough Economic Development Corporation's latest report indicates that the MSA's cost of living is **10 percent lower than the national average.** With a national average index of 100, Tampa Bay's COLI was 90.1. Compared to other Florida metro areas in the first quarter of 2018, Tampa Bay has the second lowest cost of living index and the lowest index in housing.



Tampa Bay's economic growth jumps in Global study

The Global Metro Monitor report was released from the the Brookings Metropolitan Policy Program this month. The report assesses the economic performance of metropolitan areas according to gross domestic product, employment, and population from 2000 to 2016. In a ranking of the top 300 expanding metropolitan areas worldwide, **Tampa Bay ranked 146**. A previous report showed Tampa Bay ranked at 267. This reflects the growth of Tampa Bay region is expanding with an increase in employment and GDP.

Often times when the IOS updates on certain models, due to the update complexity, it may require a soft reboot to restart.

So, she holds down the home button and shut down at the same time and Viola, the phone reboots. She asks me for my Apple ID because it just updated, I enter it and I am back in business!

St. Petersburg ranks best parks in Florida

ST. PETERSBURG — Thanks to nearly 40,000 acres of parks, including a plethora of basketball hoops and dog parks, the city edged out Tampa, Miami, and Orlando as the best city for parks in Florida, according to an annual ranking by the Trust For Public Land.

The not-for-profit evaluated the largest 100 cities in America for median park size, spending per resident, amenities and park access when compiling its 2018 Park Score rankings.

St. Petersburg finished **15th overall in the country**, ahead of several major cities known for their outdoor lifestyle, such as San Diego, CA, Denver, CO, and Austin, TX.

74-percent of St. Petersburg residents live within a 10-minute walk of a public park, which make up 15-percent of the city's land, according to the 2018 Park Score data.

The Trust for Public Land's Park Score evaluated other criteria, such as number of public restrooms, splash pads, playgrounds and recreation centers.

"From exercise zones and free yoga in the park to annual festivals and movies in the park, St. Pete's parks offer something for everyone," Leisure Services Administrator Mike Jefferis said.
