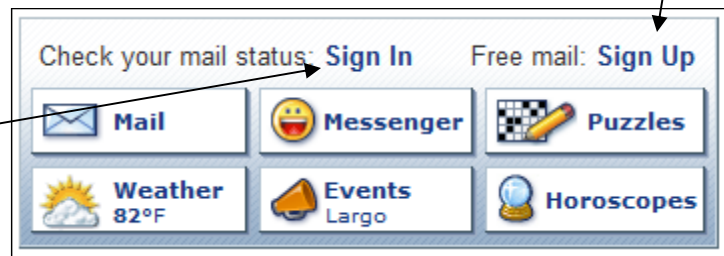


*Then select **"Sign In"***



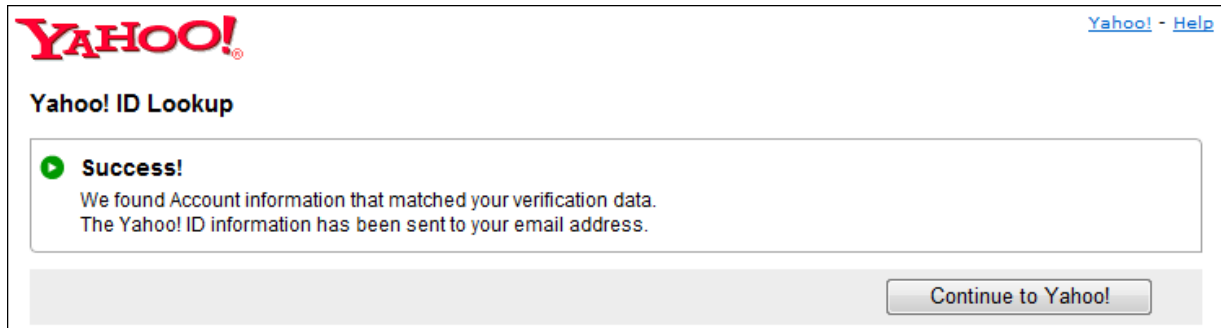

Note;

"Yahoo will send a confirmation that may go into you SPAM file -- look for it and reply to confirm."

If you have a spam filter you will need to add the Yahoo Discussion list address to your acceptable list. Some programs have a "Add to Friends button". With some programs like Microsoft Mail you can right click on the email and select "Add sender to safe sender list". If you don't do this you may find the e-mail in the Spam folder.
